Experience firsthand how our pioneers lived and worked. Learn how Innisfail started, how it grew, and what it became.



Built in 1884, the Spruces is the only remaining "Stopping House" that greeted travelers on the Calgary to Edmonton stagecoach trail, providing shelter for travelers, the military, and area pioneers. The Spruces and the stagecoach traffic, was eventually replaced with the railroad.

The school tour also includes an in depth look at how the railroad worked and the ways in which it transformed Innisfail.



"The Role of the Railroad", highlights the profound effect that the laying of tracks had on the development of our community and province. This exhibit is housed in our recently refurbished "Bowden Train Station".

These are just two of the 18 buildings and hundreds of exhibits that make up the Historical Village.

We have updated our Kindergarten and Grade 2 school program to better reflect the current curriculum requirements with Alberta Learning.

We will continue to upgrade and improve all our school programming,

Our Kindergarten program includes a teacher and student guide to assist in preparation prior to your visit. The tour includes a scavenger hunt designed to teach children about the tools our pioneers used.

Our Grades 1-4 program include a teacher and student guide to help prepare students prior to your visit.

This program offers a variety of hands-on activities that allow children to experience the way our pioneers lived and worked.

There is a large sheltered picnic area for lunches and snacks as well as an indoor hall area if the weather does not cooperate.

### **Kindergarten**

Guided program includes a teacher/student guide and an ice cream cone for the student, teacher and chaperones. \$45.00/class

### **Grade 1**

Basic, guided program, includes a teacher/student guide and includes an ice cream cone for the students, teachers and chaperones.

- \$75.00/class (max 30 students)

### **Grade 2**

Guided program based on Alberta Learning School History Curriculum. Includes a teacher/student guide and an ice cream cone for the students, teachers and chaperones.

- \$100.00/ class (max 30 students)

### **Grade 3**

Basic guided program includes teacher/student guide and includes an ice cream cone for students, teachers and chaperones.

- \$125.00/class (max 30 students)

### **Grade 4**

Basic, guided program, includes a teacher/student guide and includes an ice cream cone for the students, teachers and chaperones.

- \$150.00/class (max 30 Students)

\*Each additional student over the maximum is \$3.50/per student.
